

TITLE IV CERTIFICATION

Consistent with its recognition by the U.S. Secretary of Education, MACTE identifies Montessori teacher education institutions for the purpose of determining eligibility for Title IV student financial aid. Once an institution is granted accreditation by MACTE, it becomes eligible to apply for first-time approval to participate in the federal student financial assistance programs. Eligibility requirements and application instructions can be seen at www.eligcert.ed.gov

Forms of federal assistance available to students enrolled at eligible institutions include Stafford Loans (Federal Family Education Loans and Direct Loans) and Federal Pell Grants (these do not have to be repaid).
